Senate Amendment to H.R. 1722

Oversight and Government Reform

Telework Improvements Act of 2010

The Committee granted, by a non-record vote, a rule providing for the consideration of the Senate amendment to H.R. 1722, the Telework Improvements Act of 2010. The rule makes in order a motion offered by the chair of the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform that the House concur in the Senate amendment to H.R. 1722. The rule provides one hour of debate on the motion equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Oversight and Government Reform. The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the motion except those arising under clause 10 of rule XXI. The rule provides that the Senate amendment shall be considered as read. Finally, the rule authorizes the Speaker to entertain motions that the House suspend the rules at any time through the legislative day of November 19, 2010. The Speaker or her designee shall consult with the Minority Leader or his designee on the designation of any matter for consideration under suspension of the rules pursuant to this rule.

Senate amendments to the Claims Resolution Act of 2010

The Committee granted, by non-record vote, a rule providing for the consideration of the Senate amendments to H.R. 4783, the Claims Resolution Act of 2010. The rule makes in order a motion offered by the chair of the Committee on Natural Resources that the House concur in the Senate amendments to H.R. 4783. The rule provides one hour of debate on the motion, with 50 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Natural Resources and 10 minutes equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Ways and Means. The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the motion. Finally, the rule provides that the Senate amendments shall be considered as read.

H.J. Res. 101 Appropriations

The Committee granted, by a non-record vote, a closed rule providing for consideration of H.J. Res. 101, "Making further continuing appropriations for fiscal year 2011, and for other purposes". The rule provides 1 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Appropriations. The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the joint resolution except those arising under clause 9 or 10 of rule XXI. The rule provides that the joint resolution shall be considered as read. The rule waives all points of order against the joint resolution. Finally, the rule provides one motion to recommit with or without instructions.

S. 3307 Education and Labor

Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010

The Committee granted, by a non-record vote, a closed rule providing for consideration of S. 3307, the "Healthy, Hunger-Free Kids Act of 2010." The rule provides 1 hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the chair and ranking minority member of the Committee on Education and Labor. The rule waives all points of order against consideration of the bill except those arising under clause 9 of rule XXI. The rule provides that the bill shall be considered as read. The rule waives all points of order against the bill. Finally, the rule provides one motion to recommit with or without instructions.
