COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

September 2012

The Committee continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. (An enumeration of those laws and rules is found in H. Rep. 111-707, Summary of Activities, One Hundred Eleventh Congress, A Report of the Committee on Standards of Official Conduct, 111th Cong., 2d Sess. (Jan. 3, 2011).) As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 18 requests for advisory opinions in September of 2012. Advisory materials the Committee has publicly released are available on the Committee's Web site, at http://ethics.house.gov/.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives of the 112th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received 83 such requests in September of 2012.

In addition, the Committee is required under the House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees, and new officers or employees must receive training not later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in September of 2012. The Committee provided live training sessions attended by 134 individuals in September of 2012. The Committee also continued to provide training online, through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming in-person training sessions and online training opportunities is available on the Committee's Web site, at http://ethics.house.gov/.

The Committee released a general advisory on September 18, 2012, *Purchase of Tablet Computers with Principal Campaign Committee Funds*. The Committee released a general advisory on September 29, 2012, *Reminder: Spouse PTR Transaction Reporting Begins September 30, 2012*. The general advisories are available on the Committee's Web site, at http://ethics.house.gov/.

The Committee released two public statements regarding investigative matters in September of 2012. Acting Chairman Bob Goodlatte and Acting Ranking Member John Yarmuth in the Matter of Representative Maxine Waters released a public statement, on September 20, 2012, announcing a public hearing in the Matter of Representative Maxine Waters. Acting Chairman Bob Goodlatte and Acting Ranking Member John Yarmuth in the Matter of Representative Maxine Waters released a public statement, on September 25, 2012, that the Committee adopted by a unanimous vote, a Report based on its independent review, that Representative Waters did not violate House rules. However, the Committee unanimously voted to issue a letter of reproval to Representative Waters' Chief of Staff, Mikael Moore. The public
