October 2018

The Committee continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct.¹ As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 20 requests for advisory opinions in October of 2018.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 115th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 60 new travel requests in October of 2018 for travel beginning in October or later. There were also 175 travelers who went on Committee approved, privately-sponsored, officially connected trips within the month of October.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in October of 2018. The Committee provided live training sessions attended by 171 individuals in October of 2018. The Committee also continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming in-person training sessions and online training opportunities is available on the Committee's website at https://ethics.house.gov/.

In October 2018, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for September 2018 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.
