- Tuesday, October 4, 2011—The Subcommittee on National Parks, Forests and Public Lands held a Legislative Hearing on H.R. 854, to authorize the Peace Corps Commemorative Foundation to establish a commemorative work in the District of Columbia and its environs, and for other purposes.
