#### **COMMITTEE ON ETHICS**

#### December 2011

The Committee continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct. (An enumeration of those laws and rules is found in H. Rep. 111-707, Summary of Activities, One Hundred Eleventh Congress, A Report of the Committee on Standards of Official Conduct, 111<sup>th</sup> Cong., 2d Sess. (Jan. 3, 2011).) As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 41 requests for advisory opinions in December of 2011. Advisory materials the Committee has publicly released are available on the Committee's Web site, at <a href="http://ethics.house.gov/">http://ethics.house.gov/</a>.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives of the 112<sup>th</sup> Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received 181 such requests in December of 2011.

In addition, the Committee is required under the House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees, and new officers or employees must receive training not later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in December of 2011. The Committee provided live training sessions attended by 104 individuals in December of 2011. The Committee also continued to provide training online, through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming in-person training sessions and online training opportunities is available on the Committee's Web site, at <a href="http://ethics.house.gov/">http://ethics.house.gov/</a>.

In December 2011, the Committee issued general advisories on three topics: *Holiday Guidance on the Gift Rule, Revised Legal Expense Fund Regulations, Reminder about 2011 Annual Ethics Training Requirement.* These general advisories were distributed to the House community and are available on the Committee's Web site, at <a href="http://ethics.house.gov/">http://ethics.house.gov/</a>.

The Committee made a public announcement on December 2, 2011, that the Chairman and Ranking Member jointly decided to extend the Committee's review of the Matter of Representative Jesse Jackson, Jr. in order to gather additional information necessary to complete its review. The Committee made a public announcement on December 16, 2011, that the Committee voted unanimously to continue the service of William R. Martin as outside counsel to the Committee in the Matter of Representative Maxine Waters. The Committee made a public statement on December 20, 2011, that the Committee unanimously voted to release a public Report finding that Representative Don Young did not violate any provision of the Code of Official Conduct or any law, rule, regulation, or other standard of conduct with respect to the

receipt of 12 contributions to his legal expense trust fund. The Committee made a public statement on December 22, 2011, that the Chairman and Ranking Member jointly decided to extend the Matter regarding Representative Vern Buchanan, which was transmitted to the Committee by the Office of Congressional Ethics.
