COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

June 2016

The Committee continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct.¹ As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 31 requests for advisory opinions in June of 2016.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 114th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received 145 such requests in June of 2016.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in June of 2016. The Committee provided live training sessions attended by 235 individuals in June of 2016. The Committee also continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming in-person training sessions and online training opportunities is available on the Committee's Web site at https://ethics.house.gov/.

The Committee released three public statements in June of 2016 regarding the matter of Representative Vernon G. Buchanan, the matter of Representative Chaka Fattah, and the matter of Representative Roger Williams.
