November 2018

The Committee continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct.¹ As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 16 requests for advisory opinions in November of 2018.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 115th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 44 new travel requests in November of 2018 for travel beginning in November or later. There were also 96 travelers who went on Committee approved, privately-sponsored, officially connected trips within the month of November.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in November of 2018. The Committee provided live training sessions attended by 80 individuals in November of 2018. The Committee also continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. The Committee also provided live training sessions to 42 Members-Elect and provided live training sessions to 49 Member-Elect designees in November 2018. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming in-person training sessions and online training opportunities is available on the Committee's website at https://ethics.house.gov/.

In November 2018, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for October 2018 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.

The Committee released four public statements in November 2018 regarding the matter of Representative Mark Meadows, regarding Representative Ruben Kihuen, regarding the passage of legislation to reform the Congressional Accountability Act, and regarding Representative Jim Renacci.
