COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

March 2020

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct.¹ As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. The Committee received 22 requests for advisory opinions in March 2020.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 116th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 76 new travel requests in March 2020 for travel beginning in March or later. In total, 155 travel requests scheduled to depart in March of 2020 were withdrawn while under Committee review. In addition, 4 House travelers went on privately-sponsored, officially connected trips within the month of March that the Committee previously approved.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in March of 2020. In March of 2020, the Committee provided 1 live training session attended by 99 employees. The Committee also continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. Effective March 11, the Committee has waived the live training requirement for new employees who work in Capitol Hill offices, until further notice. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming training opportunities is available on the Committee's website at https://ethics.house.gov/.

In March 2020, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for February 2020 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.

The Committee released 2 general advisories in March 2020 regarding Campaign-related Media Appearances on Congressional Grounds and Joint House Administration-Ethics Committees Guidance on the Coronavirus. The Committee also circulated an e-Dear Colleague advisory regarding Live Ethics Training for New Employees in Capitol Hill Offices.
