COMMITTEE ON ETHICS

July 2020

The Committee on Ethics (Committee) continued to fulfill its responsibilities to advise and educate Members and staff on the laws, rules, and standards of conduct.¹ As a general matter, the Committee's activities in receiving and responding to requests for advice from House Members and staff are conducted on a confidential basis. Notwithstanding the disruption to normal operations resulting from the coronavirus pandemic, the Committee conducted its regular advisory and investigative functions via telework in July 2020. The Committee received 28 requests for advisory opinions in July 2020.

In accordance with the Rules of the House of Representatives for the 116th Congress, the Committee continued to review and approve requests to accept privately-sponsored, officially-connected travel. The Committee received and reviewed 7 new travel requests in July 2020 for travel beginning in July or later. In addition, no House travelers went on a privately-sponsored, officially connected trip within the month of July that the Committee previously approved.

In addition, the Committee is required under House rules to offer annual ethics training to each Member, Delegate, Resident Commissioner, officer, and employee of the House. Such training is mandatory for all House officers and employees. New Members, officers, and employees must receive training no later than 60 days after beginning service to the House. The Committee continued to provide such training in July of 2020. The Committee continued to provide training online and through a number of training videos. Additional information about the calendar of upcoming training opportunities is available on the Committee's website at https://ethics.house.gov/.

In July 2020, the Committee issued a summary of its activities for June 2020 directed to the Committee on House Administration. This statement is publicly available on the Committee on House Administration's website.

The Committee released 3 public statements in July 2020 regarding Representatives Lori Trahan, Stanford Bishop, and David Schweikert. Prior public statements are available on the Committee's website at https://ethics.house.gov/.

On July 31st, 2020, the Committee's Chairman and Ranking Member introduced, and the full House adopted, H.Res. 1074, recommending that the House adopt the Committee's report In the Matter of Allegations Relating to Representative David Schweikert. The resolution served as a reprimand of Representative Schweikert for 11 violations of House Rules, the Code of Ethics for Government Service, federal laws, and other applicable standards of conduct, and also imposed a \$50,000 fine to be paid by Representative Schweikert to the U.S. Treasury.
