

**ACTIVITY REPORT
FOR THE MONTH OF JANUARY 2020**

The Full Committee conducted the following hearings and/or meetings during the month of January 2020:

Wednesday, January 15, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 306, To direct the Secretary of the Interior to conduct a special resource study of the site of the Kettle Creek Battlefield Study Act in Wilkes County, Georgia, and adjacent property, and for other purposes. *"Kettle Creek Battlefield Study Act."*

Wednesday, January 15, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 496, To direct the Director of the United States Geological Survey to establish a program to map zones that are at greater risk of sinkhole formation, and for other purposes. *"Sinkhole Mapping Act of 2019."*

Wednesday, January 15, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 895, To allow tribal grant schools to participate in the Federal Employee Health Benefits program. *"Tribal School Federal Insurance Parity Act."*

Wednesday, January 15, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 1702, To waive the application fee for any special use permit for veterans demonstrations and special events at war memorials on Federal land, and for other purposes. *"Free Veterans from Fees Act."*

Wednesday, January 15, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 2640, To withdraw certain Bureau of Land Management land from mineral development. *"Buffalo Tract Protection Act."*

Wednesday, January 15, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 3068, To establish an offshore wind career training grant program, and for other purposes. *"Offshore Wind Jobs and Opportunity Act."*

Wednesday, January 15, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 3160, To direct the Secretary of the Interior to take certain land located in Pinal County, Arizona, into trust for the benefit of the Gila River Indian Community, and for other purposes. *"Blackwater Trading Post Land Transfer Act."*

Wednesday, January 15, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 3465, To authorize the Fallen Journalists Memorial Foundation to establish a commemorative work in the District of Columbia and its environs, and for other purposes. *"Fallen Journalists Memorial Act of 2019."*

Wednesday, January 15, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 4248, To amend the Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act of 1977 to allow the Secretary of the Interior to delegate certain emergency reclamation activities to the States and Tribes, and for other purposes. *"Surface Mining Control and Reclamation Act Amendments of 2019."*

Wednesday, January 15, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 5552, To amend the Migratory Bird Treaty Act to affirm that the Migratory Bird Treaty Act's prohibition on the unauthorized take or killing of migratory birds includes incidental take by commercial activities, and to direct the United States Fish and Wildlife Service to regulate such incidental take, and for other purposes. "*Migratory Bird Protection Act of 2020.*"

Wednesday, January 29, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 1049, To authorize a National Heritage Area Program, and for other purposes. "*National Heritage Area Act of 2019.*"

Wednesday, January 29, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 1240, To preserve United States fishing heritage through a national program dedicated to training and assisting the next generation of commercial fishermen.

Wednesday, January 29, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 2748, To establish an integrated national approach to respond to ongoing and expected effects of extreme weather and climate change by protecting, managing, and conserving the fish, wildlife, and plants of the United States, and to maximize Government efficiency and reduce costs, in cooperation with State, local, and Tribal Governments and other entities, and for other purposes. "*Safeguarding America's Future and Environment Act.*"

Wednesday, January 29, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 2795, To establish National Wildlife Corridors to provide for the protection and restoration of certain native fish, wildlife, and plant species, and for other purposes. "*Wildlife Corridors Conservation Act of 2019.*"

Wednesday, January 29, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 2956, To provide for the establishment of the Western Riverside County Wildlife Refuge.

Wednesday, January 29, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 3399, To amend the Nutria Eradication and Control Act of 2003 to include California in the program, and for other purposes.

Wednesday, January 29, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 4348, To terminate certain rules issued by the Secretary of the Interior and the Secretary of Commerce relating to endangered and threatened species, and for other purposes. "*Protect America's Wildlife and Fish In Need of Conservation Act of 2019.*"

Wednesday, January 29, 2020---The Full Committee held a markup on H.R. 4679, To require the Comptroller General of the United States to submit to Congress a report examining efforts by the Regional Fishery Management Councils, the Atlantic States Marine Fisheries Commission, and the National Marine Fisheries Service to prepare and adapt United States fishery management for the impacts of climate change, and for other purposes. Tuesday, January 14, 2020---The Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife held a Legislative Hearing on H.R. 1834, To direct the Secretary of Commerce to issue regulations prohibiting the use of sunscreen containing oxybenzone or octinoxate in a National Marine Sanctuary in which coral is present, and for other purposes. *"Defending Our National Marine Sanctuaries from Damaging Chemicals Act of 2019."*

Tuesday, January 14, 2020---The Subcommittee on Water, Oceans, and Wildlife held a Legislative Hearing on H.R. 2236, To improve the management of forage fish. *"Forage Fish Conservation Act."*
