Amend Agenda Document No. 23-01-B1 to add a new Section V:

V: Commission Report to the Public

Within six months following the conclusion of the 2023-2024 cycle audits, and within six months following the conclusion of every subsequent election-cycle audits, the Commission will report to the public on how the new procedures are achieving the goals set forth in the final paragraph of the introduction to the explanation of these procedures: “to strike the appropriate balance, within the constraints of the Act, among efficiency, procedural protections for audited committees, orderly development of the law, transparency, and the Commission’s statutory authority to seek voluntary compliance with the Act.”

Commissioners Broussard and Weintraub voted affirmatively for the motion.

Commissioners Cooksey, Dickerson, Lindenbaum, Trainor dissented.

3. Decided by a vote of 6-0 to:

Approve Agenda Document No. 23-10-B1, which is the Revised Audit Process
For Committees That Do Not Receive Public Funds.
